Races will be held in Northwest Creek in the vicinity of the mouth of Spring Creek. Sunfish and other dinghies (tenders) will sail as classes if there are 3 or more boats per class. There also will be an open class competition for small boats which do not constitute a one design class.

Starting time for the first race each day will be **1400**. A Captain's meeting will be held prior to the first race on *March 25 at 1330* on the lawn at 5620 Gondolier Dr. Sailing instructions will be given at this meeting.

Weather permitting; three races will be sailed each race day. Low point scoring system will be used the winner of a race will get 1 point, number 2, 2 etc. The best 12 of 15 races will be scored.

An Awards Party will be held after the last race at 5620 Gondolier Dr.

Races will be conducted under the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing except as modified by specific references in the sailing instructions.

In the event of inclement weather races may be cancelled by email at or before 1200 on race day.
