

# Tuesday FUN Racing Returns 2012

## Here is the plan:

Beginning 10 April, anyone who is interested will meet at marker N1. From there we will race to another fixed aid and back. The race will start at 5:00 PM.

On most days, the course is expected to be from 1N to #17 and back. If the wind is really strong, we might suggest twice around. If the wind is close to being from 020degM or 200degM, we might suggest employing the offset mark (located at 35°02.35'N 076°58.98'W) so that our downwind leg is not dead astern.

## By Informal we mean:

No Captains' meeting

No committee boat

No protests

No spinnakers

No Shouting

No railmeat

Small crew sizes, preferably a couple or joint boat owners. Not a full racing crew.

We will either provide a non-racing safety boat OR ask one of the faster racers to serve as a safety boat. This would be in addition to their racing (not in lieu of).

The start will be a pursuit start, meaning that your starting time is computed ahead of time based upon your handicap. Courses and start times will be sent to each competitor.

Theoretically, everyone finishes at the same time, therefore, first across the finish line wins.

One of us will get on the radio (VHF-69) with course changes and a 10 minute time check. You are expected to pass (start/finish) within 100' of N1. After each race, phone or e-mail to Buddy or Paul the name of boat that finished either in front of you or behind. Scoring will be published to each competitor via e-mail.

Since we are trying this as a fun non-sponsored activity, there is no entry fee and no awards.

Boat owners do not need to be members of any sailing club, yacht club, or racing association, however, a waiver of liability is required to be signed by the boat owner. As always, captains are individually responsible for their own actions and any damage caused.
